

Make Your Own Paper Dolls William Paper Doll



Instructions

- 1. Print doll on paper.
- 2. Glue printed doll on a piece of cardboard (e.g., cereal box cardboard)
 Let glue dry.
- 3. Follow the dotted line to cut out doll. Cut tab.
- Fold tab and insert into the two slits, on the base of doll.




Instructions
