GATHERING POINT:	Canadian Museum of History's shoreline.	Flat surface made of stones.
BOARDING LOCATION:	Rabaska Canada's main dock located on the shore of the Canadian Museum of History.	Mostly grass. Dock (floating flat surface).
LOCATION OF THE ACTIVITY:	Ottawa River.	Because the activity takes place on water, the canoe may experience the effect of waves and wind.
LOCATION OF THE END OF THE ACTIVITY:	Rabaska Canada's main dock located on the shore of the Canadian Museum of History.	Same as boarding location.

Overview of necessary travels

Travel by foot: An about 50 meter walk will be necessary to get to the dock.

Water travel: The canoe travel is about 5 km long and is accompanied by a

guide who will be in the same canoe as the participants.

Materials and accessories to bring with you

- A min 500 ml water bottle;
- Sunscreen;
- Sunglasses.

Clothes

We highly recommend that each participant wears:

- Weather appropriate clothing;
- Closed toe shoes (water footwear isn't mandatory);
- Fast drying clothes.
