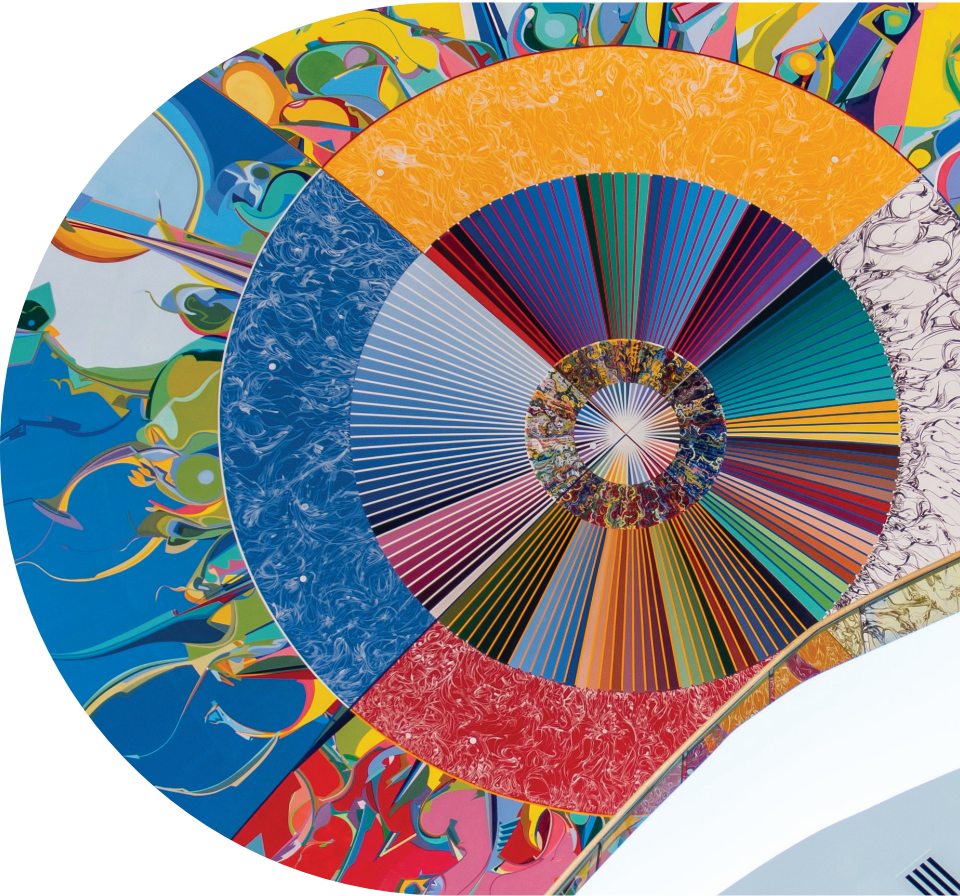

GRAND HALL

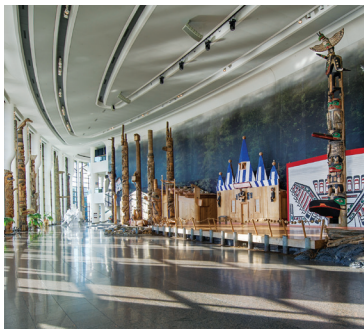
The Grand Hall is the architectural focal point of the Museum and houses the world's largest collection of totem poles.

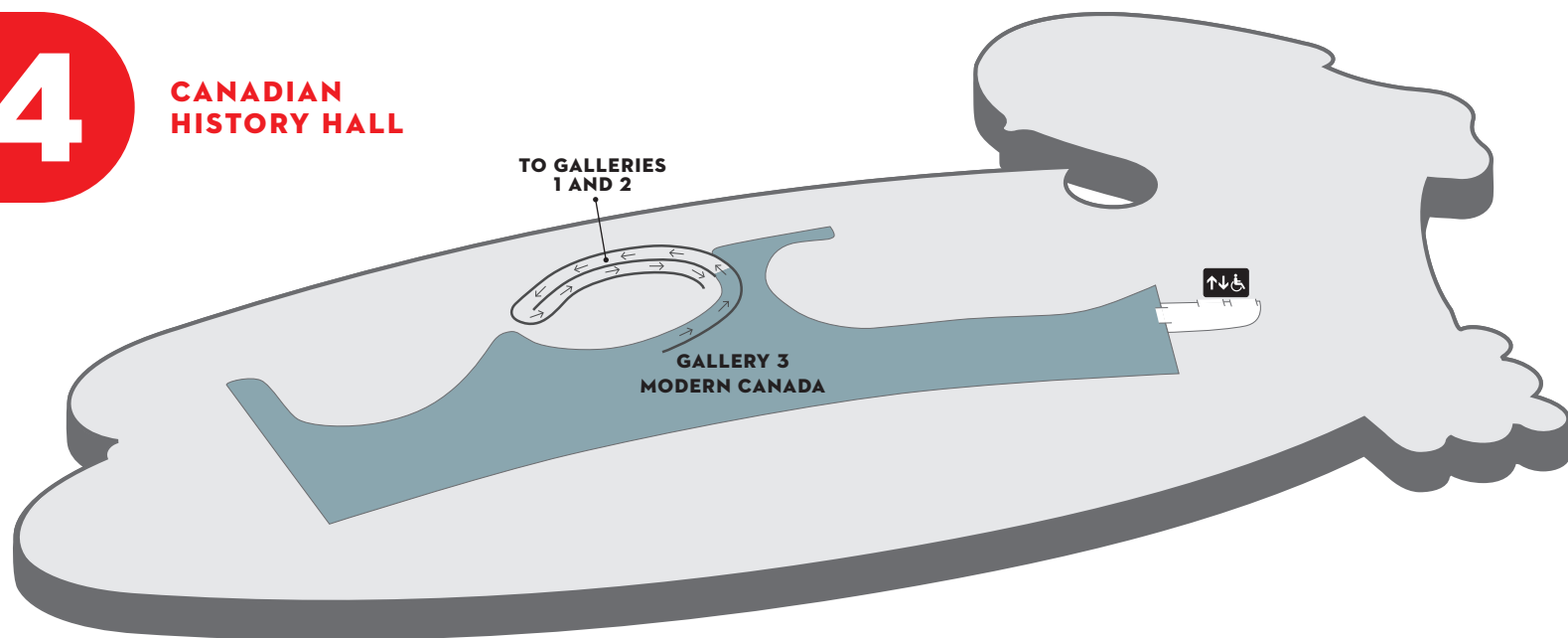

This massive red-cedar sculpture, created by Kwagu't master carver Stanley C. Hunt, is a memorial to the children who never returned from Canada's residential schools.

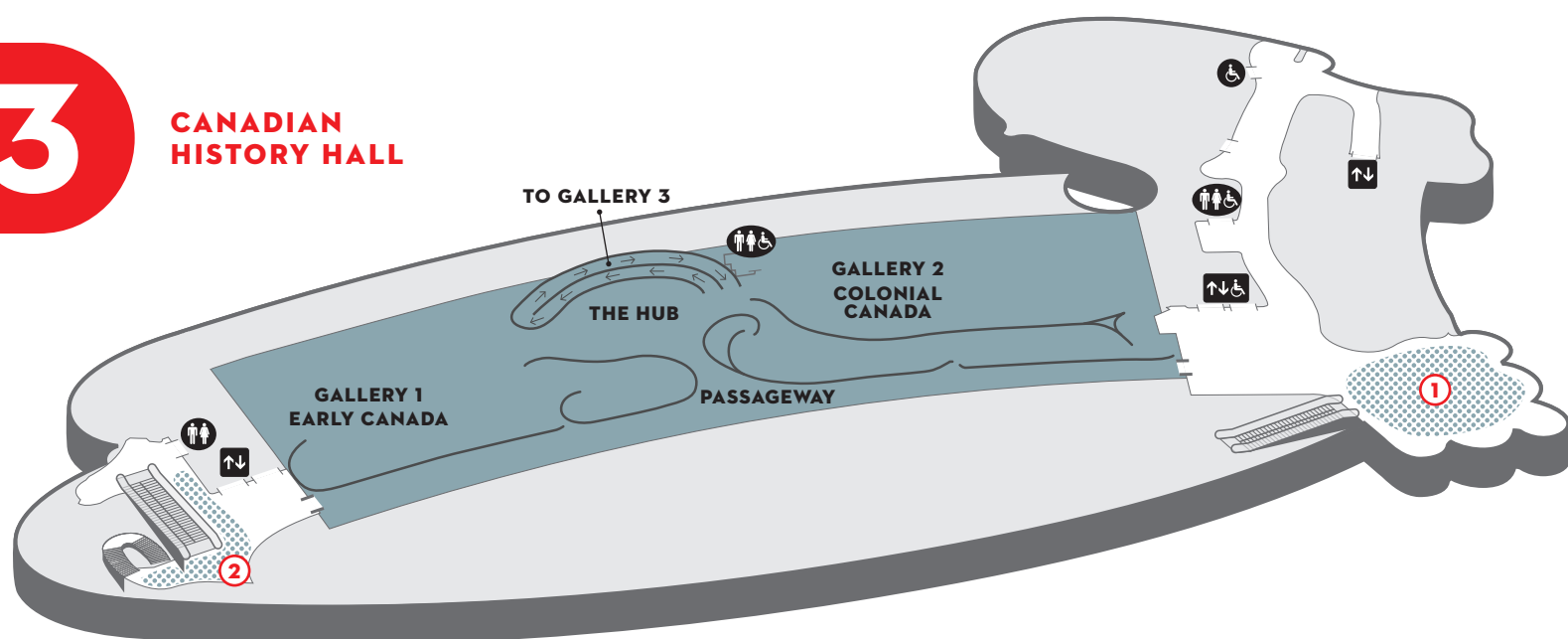

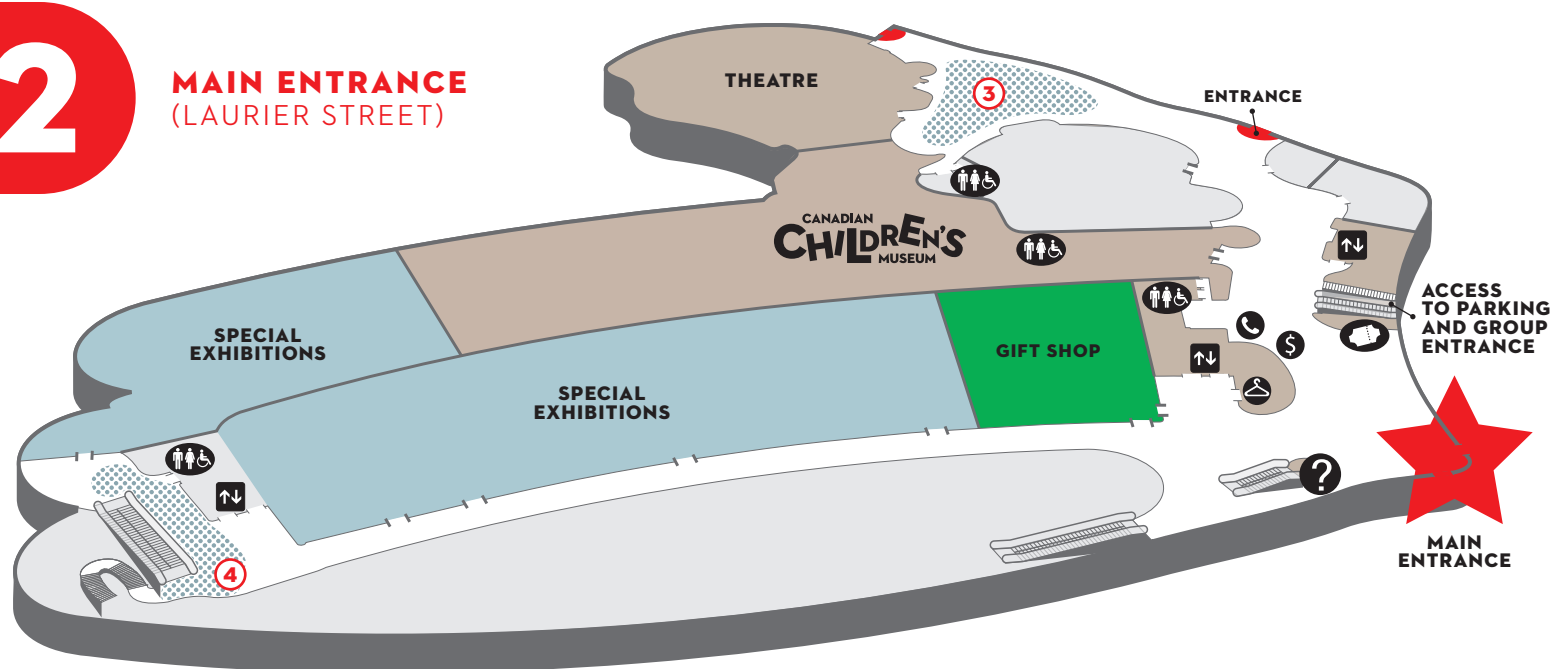

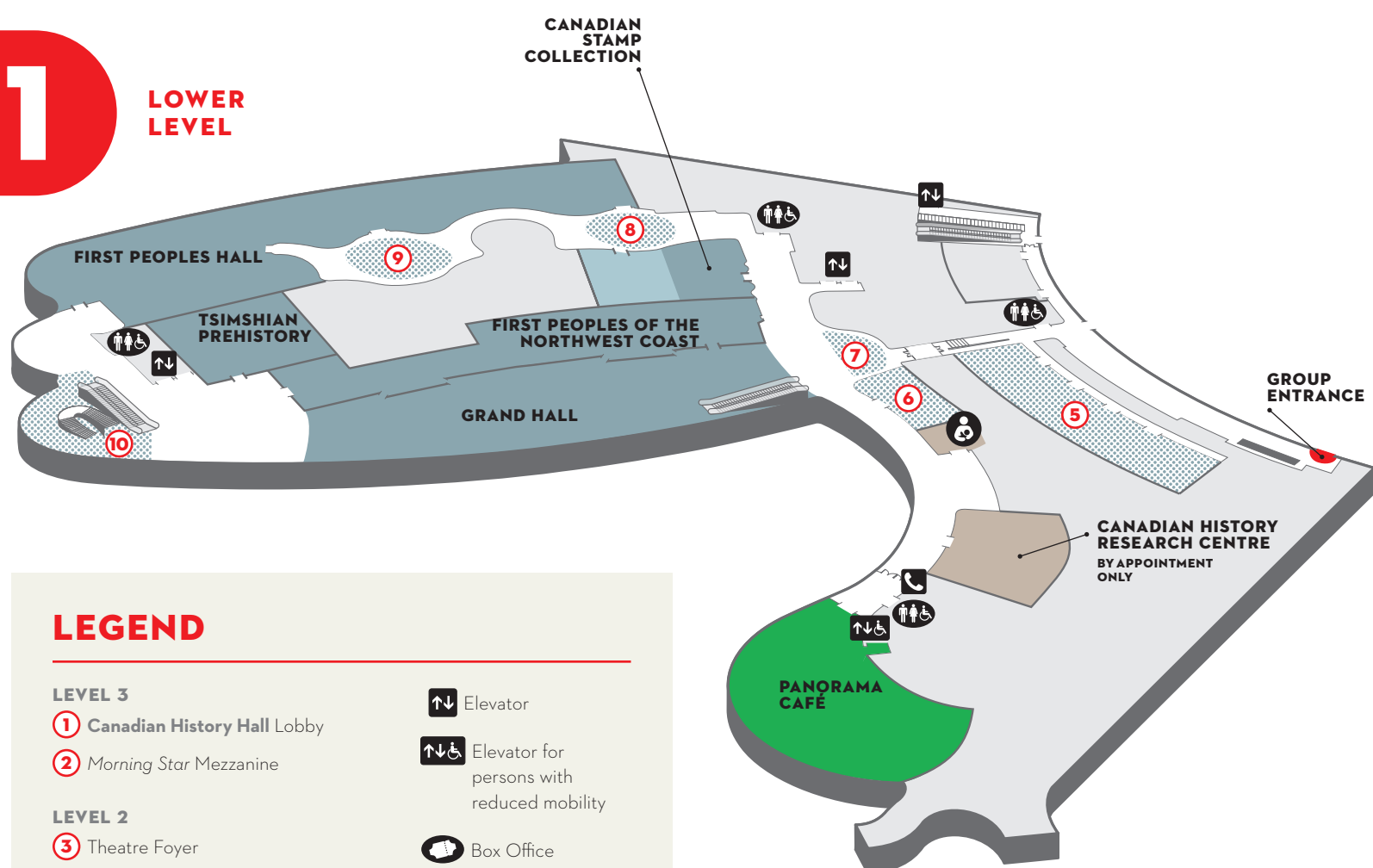
